Devere Hall UCC – Isabelle Huppert Reads Maupassant

Fully accessible venue.

Wheelchair bathroom available.

Serviced by regular Bus Eireann services.

Cork Opera House - 1975 / NAOI DÉAG SEACHTÓ CÚIG

This is an accessible venue with a wheelchair lift on the ground floor and an accessible toilet located on the top floor.

For comfort and convenience please call Box Office to book a seat (021 427 0022).

An induction loop is in operation for patrons with hearing difficulties.

People with hearing aids should set them to 'T'.

Concert Hall, Cork City Hall – Ten Thousand Hours

This venue is wheelchair accessible.

Accessible door to the left of Terence McSweeney entrance with a ramp leading to the door.

Disabled parking bays: next to Garda Station, and on Lapps Quay - 2 bays

Wheelchair bathroom available.

Millennium Hall Cork City Hall – Cúinní an Ghiorria

ISL Interpretation on Sunday 21 June at 7pm.

This venue is wheelchair accessible.

Wheelchair bathroom available.

Accessible door to the left of Terence McSweeney entrance with a ramp leading to the door.

Disabled parking bays: next to Garda Station, and on Lapps Quay - 2 bays

Wheelchair bathroom available.

Elizabeth Fort - Solstice Céilí

Includes flashing lights and loud music.

This event is wheelchair accessible however due to being located outside the ground is covered in sand and uneven in places. Main entrance -2.4m

There is an accessible portaloo on site suitable for manual wheelchairs.

Accessible toilet doorway: 83cm

Disabled parking Bay: Bishop St at Probys Quay - one bay only.

Elizabeth Fort – An Casadh (The Turn)

Outdoor exhibits are accessible.

No wheelchair access to buildings (multiple steps).

Fugit – Multiple Venues

Unfortunately, due to the nature of this performance, it is not suitable for anyone with limited mobility or using a wheelchair.

Marina Market Event Room – The Homecoming of Joseph Grace

This venue is wheelchair accessible.

Marina Market has parking on-site and has toilet facilities with disabled access. The bathroom is large and able to accommodate power chairs.

Swimming Pool underneath the Metropole – Pool (No Water)

Live captions with the Sibrd App on Saturday 27 June at 2pm and 7pm

Unfortunately, this venue is not wheelchair accessible.

The Pav – Drink Rum with Ex-Pats

Unfortunately, this venue is not wheelchair accessible as there is no lift to access upstairs.

Triskel Arts Centre – Fingerprints

Wheelchair access is via Tobin Street. There is a lift from the Box Office area. The entire central aisle is available to wheelchair users and is accessed by going up a ramp. The space can be dark when entering and the flooring is uneven in places.

The venue has two accessible toilets on the ground and first floors.

Triskel does not have any parking.

Disabled Parking Bay: South Main Street, 2 Bays.

CTC Studio at Triskel Arts Centre – Housework

Wheelchair access is via Tobin Street. The venue is on the ground floor with step free access.

The venue has two accessible toilets on the ground and first floors.

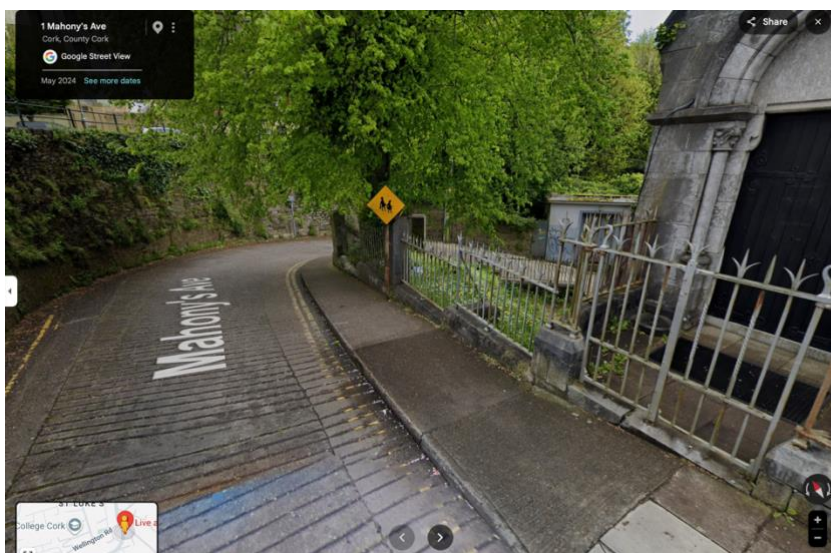

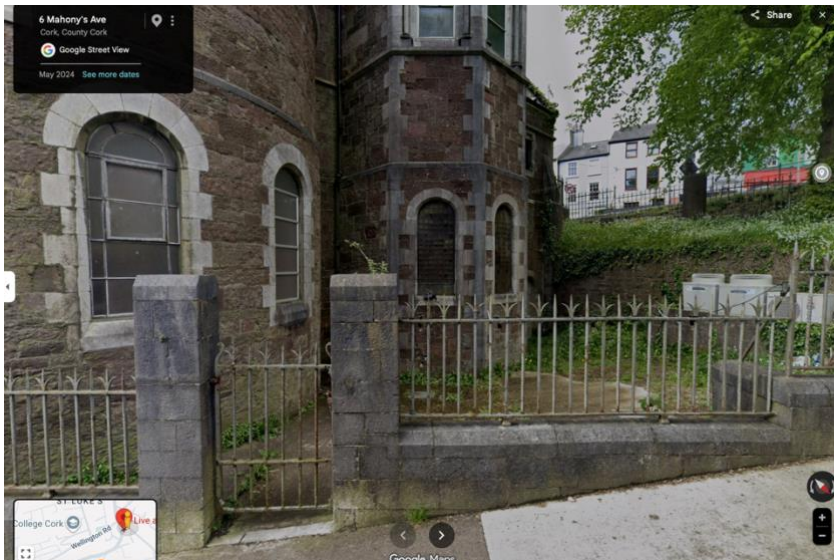
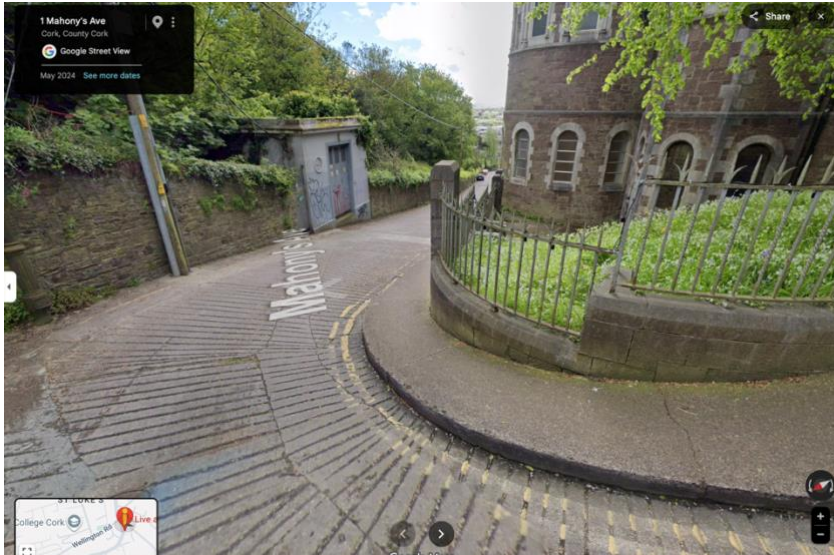
Disabled Parking Bay: South Main Street, 2 Bays.

The Crypt, St Luke’s – Distillation & Dignity (ISL production)

This venue is wheelchair accessible.

However to access the space you must walk down a very steep decline on [Mahony’s Ave](#) where the ground is uneven and difficult to navigate the limited mobility. See images below.





Once you reach the end of the decline you enter via a gate followed by a wooden door.

Venue door: 71.5cm

Accessible Toilet door: 71.5cm

The Everyman – 0800 Cupid

The theatre is wheelchair accessible, with step-free access to the Theatre Box Office and to the stalls in the theatre auditorium. There is also step-free access to The Everyman Bar. The theatre provides a gender-neutral wheelchair accessible toilet.

Please advise box office at time of booking if you have access requirements on 021 450 1673.

Disabled Parking Bay: McCurtain Street, 3 Bays.

Dance Cork Firkin Crane – Offspring (A Modern Frankenstein)

The venue is wheelchair accessible with an accessible bathroom.

If you have any mobility issues, please contact the Box Office 021-4507487 in advance to book your tickets: there is seating section reserved in the theatre for wheelchairs, but this cannot currently be booked online.

Disabled Parking Bay: Pope's Quay, 4 Bays. 5 minutes away.

Q-Park Carroll's Quay 5 minutes away.

Curtis Auditorium MTU Cork School of Music – Dances for the city (In time of Angst)

The venue is wheelchair accessible with an accessible bathroom.

The venue provides step-free access and dedicated spaces to accommodate wheelchair users in the Curtis Auditorium.

Disabled parking bay: outside CSM - 3 bays available on Union Quay.

Stack Theatre MTU Cork School of Music – The Lost Tapes of Lydia Howell

ISL interpretation on Saturday 20 June at 5pm.

The venue is wheelchair accessible with an accessible bathroom.

The Stack Theatre, located on the ground floor, is fully wheelchair accessible. The 120-seat flexible venue features flat seating areas and accommodates up to 4 wheelchair spaces.

Disabled parking bay: outside CSM - 3 bays available on Union Quay.

Cork Arts Theatre – Constellations

The venue is wheelchair accessible with an accessible bathroom.

Parking is available directly opposite the venue in the Carroll's Quay Car Park.

If any members of your group have mobility issues or require assistance, please inform the Theatre in advance of your arrival to reserve suitable seating.

Atkin's Hall – Said The Dead

Unfortunately venue isn't wheelchair accessible.

Lots of available parking

The Granary Theatre – Stimphony (*Embedded ISL & live captions*),
The Music Of What Happens, Home Entertainment

The Granary Theatre is an accessible venue with an accessible toilet.
Disability parking bays: oDyke Parade with 2 bays, 200 meters from venue.
Alternative Parking Bays include:
Little Hanover Street: 1 space, 4 minutes from the venue.
Washington Street: 2 space, 7 minutes from the venue.

The Savoy – Betweenness (on loop)

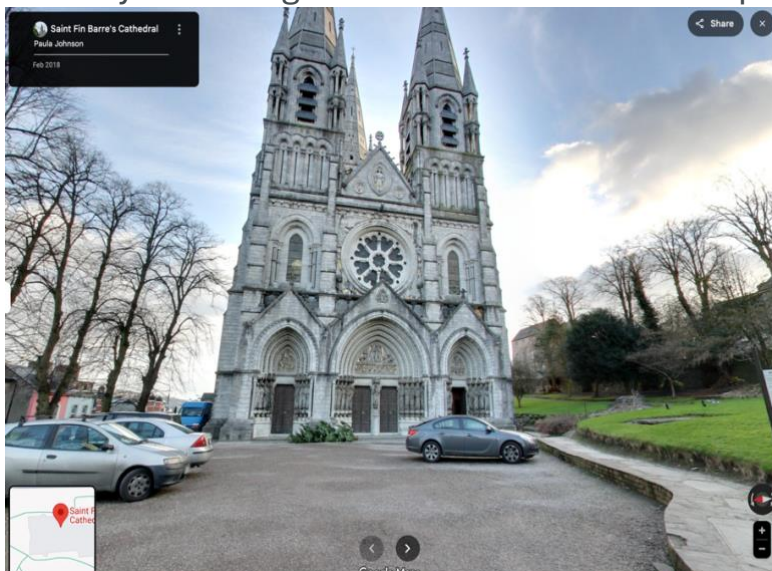
Unfortunately, this venue is not wheelchair accessible as there is no lift to access upstairs.

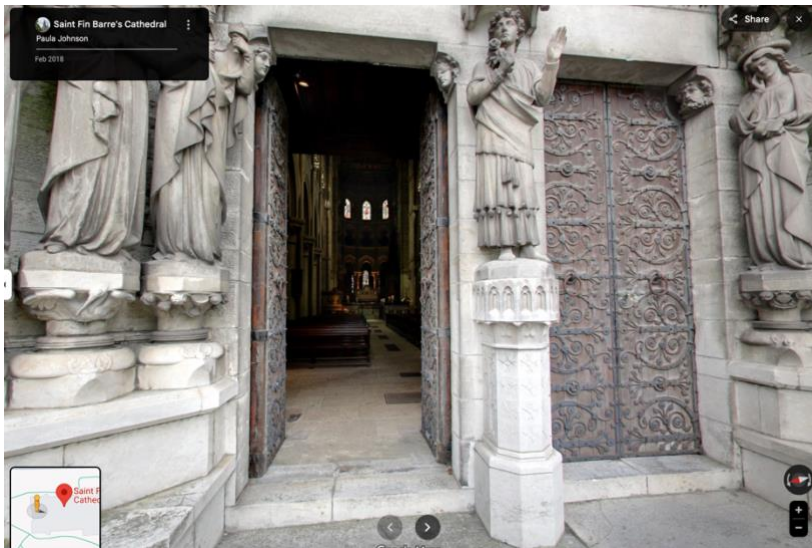
The Glucksman – On Repetition & Absence

The venue is wheelchair accessible with a power assisted entrance. The Glucksman has 5 floors and all can be accessed by lift with braille buttons. A gender neutral, accessible toilet with a low sink and wall mounted rails is located in Gallery 1 (Level 2), please note this toilet does not contain a hoist system.

St Fin Barre’s Cathedral - Idrîsî Ensemble

The cathedral is wheelchair accessible. Access is provided by placing a ramp to navigate the small step at the entrance.
The terrain around the cathedral is gravel and may be difficult with limited mobility. See images below for reference. No public toilets are available.

UCC Centre for Executive Education, Lapp's Quay – Assembly: Ireland at Venice 2025

The venue is fully accessible with lifts and an accessible bathroom.

Oliver Plunkett St. – Midsummer Parade

Accessible viewing area at 7 Cook Street next to Murphy's Ice Cream. Ear defenders are recommended for those sensitive to loud noise.

Cork City Library

The venue is fully accessible with an accessible bathroom.

A hearing loop system is fitted.

St. Peters

The venue is fully accessible with an accessible entrance (slightly uneven terrain)

There is a lift inside to access the mezzanine level and accessible bathrooms are provided.

Bishop Lucey Park – The Wiggle Wagon

The park is fully accessible.

Ramps are available to access raised areas of the park.

Fitzgerald’s Park – Soundburst

The park is fully accessible.

Clashduv Park – Global Garden

The park is fully accessible and has matting on the ground to make the terrain more manageable for those with limited mobility.

Plugd

This venue is not wheelchair accessible.

Test Site

Wheelchair-accessible venue however as an outdoor venue the terrain is gravel and may be difficult with limited mobility.

No public bathrooms on site but the nearest accessible bathroom is downstairs in the Cornmarket Centre.

Graffiti Theatre – Singing Garden

This venue is wheelchair accessible. There is a wheelchair-accessible toilet on site. Please contact Graffiti Theatre ahead of arrival to ensure they allocated suitable seating and have the accessible entrance ready (021) 439 7111

St. Patricks Street - Féasta

Fully accessible with open flat space on the street to enjoy the food & craft market.
